WeeGreen & RE-volv: This Memorial Day Let Solar Shine for the Vets

Coastal Carolina University Launches <u>Volts4Vets</u> & Uses Cutting Edge Online Platform to Honor our Vets and Install Solar on VFW

Conway, SC – Student Solar Ambassadors at Coastal Carolina University have been working all year to put solar on the local Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) building in Little River, SC. And thanks to WeeGreen, a cutting edge "green campaign" platform, Re-volv, and the Leonardo DiCaprio Foundation they are close to making their goal!

The Conway VFW Post 10804 will be the first non-profit community building to have solar power installed in 2018 thanks to this unique partnership.

Through a partnership with Re-volv, the Leonardo DiCaprio Foundation has committed a portion of funding to make the project a happen. However, in order to make the project a reality, the students need to raise local funds to demonstrate buy-in and commitment. And that's where WeeGreen comes in.

The <u>WeeGreen</u> "green campaign" platform is a free, co-branded on-line platform that allows local community activists to run their own green campaigns. Along the South Carolina Grand Strand, Coastal Solar Ambassadors are running a community campaign to encourage residents to go solar. And when residents buy solar through the WeeGreen platform, a percentage of the sale goes towards the Volts4Vets Campaign – and helps put solar on the roof of the VFW.

Students at Coastal Carolina University have studied solar energy throughout the year including learning how to install systems on low-income homes in Colorado over spring

break. The students understand the financial impacts and opportunities of solar and approached the VFW as a nonprofit organization that owns its own building. Because the incentives for solar energy come from tax credits, nonprofits are usually unable to go solar.

"This is an incredibly exciting opportunity to bring together non-profit organizations, student activists, community leaders and the resources of Re-volv," said WeeGreen CEO Brian F. Keane. "Back in the day, 'Barn Raisings' were the norm. Now we're proud to be a part of 'solar raisings'. And on this Memorial Day I can't think of a better organization to help raise solar for then our Veterans."

"RE-volv's Solar Ambassador program is a new way for students to bring clean energy to their communities," said Andreas Karelas, RE-volv's founder and Executive Director. "We've created a unique method for students to have a huge impact and fight climate change. They have a path to go beyond personal action or policy support to drive clean energy solutions locally."

"We are committed to solar energy for our community, especially our veterans who have sacrificed for us and continue to serve our community. Our partnership with Re-volv and WeeGreen has empowered us and given us the tools to solarize the VFW. Together, we can continue to make positive change in our community," said Pamela Martin, Director of the Coastal Solar Ambassador program at Coastal Carolina University.
